We are pleased to invite you to the 27th Annual Great Harbor Shoot-Out, Maine's largest post-season basketball tournament for boys and girls at the junior high and high school levels. This year the tournament will take place March 15-17, 2019. With four divisions of play for girls and boys, this three-day tournament gives young people the opportunity to compete, excel and develop invaluable life skills. Last year over 80 teams competed across the four divisions, so get your registrations in quickly to reserve your spot.

The Great Harbor Shoot-Out is a fundraiser for the many programs Harbor House Community Service Center provides for the communities of Southwest Harbor & Tremont. In an effort to offset the expenses associated with this tournament and keep the registration fee reasonable, we ask that each team make every effort to secure a \$100 event Sponsor to help us defray the cost of this event. Each sponsor will be recognized in our Great Harbor Shoot-Out program. This is a great opportunity for business exposure, reaching thousands of people throughout the entire state of Maine.

Onto a few housekeeping issues:

- We are getting back to the roots of this tournament so **NO AAU teams**. Teams must consist of players who attend the same high school or, in the case of middle school teams, *will be* attending the same high school.
- **Seniors are NOT** eligible to play in this tournament.
- All teams must **PROVIDE ONE VOLUNTEER** to keep the official book for each game they play.
- Please **DO NOT ASSUME** we know you have a team playing in the 2019 tournament because you've played in prior tournaments. **YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN A SLOT UNTIL YOU REGISTER.**
- This tournament sells out quickly. Please call prior to sending your registration to ensure we have space for your team. The tournament is first come first gets a spot.
- Please note **registration and payment** are **DUE BY FEBRUARY 22, 2019.**
- We will provide t-shirts for a maximum of 12 players and 2 coaches. Please provide shirt sizes- without them we cannot guarantee you will get the correct size. We cannot guarantee sizes for registrations received after February 22rd

Great Harbor House Shoot-Out Rules & Regulations 2019

1. All tournament rules will be according to high school interpretation unless amended by the Tournament Committee.
2. Please do not arrive prior to 3:30 on Friday. School is still in session at many locations.
3. Plan to be at least 30 minutes early for each of your games.
4. All preliminary games in every bracket will consist of two 20 minute running time halves with the last 2 minutes being stop time. All four divisional championship games will be regulation length (4 eight minute quarters). Overtime will be 3 minutes for preliminary games and for championship games. 1 minute running time 2 minute stop time.
5. Each team will get two 30 second time-outs per half, no carry-over. Each team will get one 30 second time-out in over time.
7. Each team is **required** to clean up the team bench after each game. Place all recyclables in appropriate bins.
8. All teams are required to bring two sets of shirts of different colors. Reversible shirts are fine. Numbers **must** appear on the front & back of each shirt. This is a request from the referees.
9. Team listed on the top of bracket is the home team and must wear white. That team is also responsible for providing a book keeper for the official book. Please be sure that person goes to the clock table before the game starts
10. Please be sure to include sizes for t-shirts for players and coaches on the registration form.
11. Each team may have a minimum of eight or maximum of twelve players. Sorry High school seniors are not eligible to play.
12. Each location may have different facility rules. Please adhere to rules for each location.
13. Board and local officials will be assigned by the GHSO Committee chaired by Mr. Fred Berry.
14. There will be an admission fee of \$5 for adults and \$3 for students and seniors. Weekend Passes covering all venues available for \$12.00.
15. Each team will be responsible for their own team's valuables.
16. Team must bring their own practice balls. Harbor House will provide game balls for each location.
17. Players may **NOT** play on more than one team.
18. Coaches are responsible for player conduct on and off the court. Two un-sportsmen like technical fouls called on any players, coaches or fans from any team will result in expulsion from the tournament without refund.
19. Championship games in high school divisions will be one game unless it is the first loss for the team in the winner bracket, then a second game will be played.
